



Program Rules and Expectations

*Please go over this information with your child, sign and return.

The underlying objective of all theater skills taught All About Theatre, is to learn to work together cooperatively onstage. Teamwork requires that all participants demonstrate the utmost of respect for each other. We must also respect the staff, the occupants of other classrooms, and the rules of the Loudon Nelson Community Center. **All About Theatre expects** all participants to conduct themselves in a mature and responsible manner. The following list of rules stipulates the behavior that is requested and expected of all participants in the program. Violation or repeated disregard of these rules will result in possible dismissal from the program without a refund of tuition.

- **Display highest standard of respect for self and others.**
- **No children may leave premises of Loudon Nelson Community Center or the dance studio at any time during their scheduled program.**
- **No open toe shoes (i.e., no sandals).**
- **No alcohol. No drugs. No smoking.**
- **Do not chew gum.**
- **No swearing.**
- **No inappropriate public display of affection.**
- **No littering. Clean up after yourself after lunch and snack.**
- **Be courteous to staff, volunteers and fellow cast members.**
- **Listen and pay attention whether you are working or not.**
- **Inside Loudon Nelson Center & Dance Studios: No running. No exploring. No yelling.**
- **Follow the requests of teachers, staff, and supervisors.**

Repeated violations of All About Theatre Rules and Expectations will result in the implementation of disciplinary procedures, which include verbal warnings, time-outs, notification of parents/guardians, and possible dismissal.

Provisions

- Please provide your child with a *Snack* and *Water Bottle* each day.



Attendance and Safety Procedures

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- **Out of respect for teachers and classmates, please arrive on time. Late arrivers are likely to miss important information and distract the focus of the group.**
- **If student was, is or will be absent, or late, please call Director and/or Artistic Director and let them know the details. See Phone List...**
- **Because the Louden Nelson Center & Dance Studios are used by many people downtown, we prefer that adults accompany children to the classroom each day.**
- **Staff will take attendance at the beginning of each class. In order to make sure that all children are accounted for.**
- **Children who are not picked up on time, will be watched by an AAT staff member after dismissal, for up to 15 minutes. However this is not a given service and is on the personal time of the staff member so please pick your child up promptly!**

WAIVERS

Parent/Guardian may return a “Sign-In Waiver” and/or a “Sign-Out Waiver”, if your child will not be accompanied by an adult when arriving or leaving. Unless AAT has a “Sign-Out Waiver” on file, a child should not arrive or leave unattended. Please understand that filing a Sign-Out Waiver implies that AAT staff is no longer responsible for a child once that child has left at the end of the day. That means the Supervisor will not check and see that the child’s ride has come, that they are going where they are supposed to go, etc.
